With respect to all materials used by Value Plastics, please be advised that no materials contain any of the banned or restricted substances, and therefore are in full compliance with European Directive 2002/95/EC RoHS and Ministry of Information Industry Order #39 as published February 28, 2006, by the AeA China RoHS Steering Committee. Furthermore, any trace amounts of such substances are fully within the allowable limits.

Banned or restricted substances as enumerated in the Directive:

1. Lead - Pb
 - max allowed = 0.1%
2. Mercury - Hg
 - max allowed = 0.1%
3. Cadmium - Cd
 - max allowed = 0.01%
4. Hexavalent Chromium CR (VI)
 - max allowed = 0.1%
5. Polybrominated biphenyls - PBB
 - max allowed = 0.1%
6. Polybrominated diphenyl ethers - PBDE
 - max allowed = 0.1%

However, Value Plastics has not tested these materials for these banned or restricted substances. Ultimately VP customers must make their own determination that their use of our product(s) is safe, lawful (except as provided in the above certifications) and technically suitable in their intended applications.
